Youth Program

The Youth Program has 2 scholarships available annually. The motion was made and carried to increase the amount of the scholarships and to extend the deadline to March 1. The candidate can not be over 21 years of age. Brint is to get all of the specifications for the scholarships to Jerry Borden for posting on Facebook. Any youth that is interested, should email Brint Sparks a one-page report explaining why field trialing is important to them.

A motion was made that a third Youth scholarship go to the Youth Judge of the Year – motion carried.

It was also decided that the youth fund can provide something special such as a jacket for the youth judge that judges the most casts over the course of the year.

Brint is to follow up with Kimberly Kerr concerning the Youth Scholarships.

There was a unanimous motion carried to have a Youth Hunt at the US. The participant cannot be over 18 years old. All hounds, regardless of class, can participate in the one class. The Youth winner will earn 3 points toward PP Beagler Hall of Fame. All other youth participants in this Youth hunt will earn 1 point toward PP Beagler Hall Fame.

Brint suggested in order to bring more focus to the PP Youth division, that photos be taken at hunts and posted on Facebook. The US Youth hunt is a good opportunity to get photos for this purpose.

Any Youth Funds remaining at the end of the year shall carry over to the next year.
